Guidelines for “freshening up” the Green Meadows entrance flower beds:

- **Per Ohio Directives**
 - Please practice social distancing from others who are helping
 - Use Your Protective Protection – face masks
- **The Gardening**
 - As you are helping with the “cleaning”, be careful to leave the perennial flowers. If you wonder whether to leave something that is growing, just leave it.
 - If you choose to edge the flower bed, please do so. Thank you.
 - Please bring the tools that you plan to use (rakes, shovels, trimmers). If each volunteer brings their own tools, there will be less chance of infection.
- **Mulch**
 - We will order mulch for the flower beds.

 - We will contact those wishing to help when we have a delivery date, and we will establish an agreed-to date and time for your participation. There will be a minimal number of people at any one time, per the Ohio Directives.
